

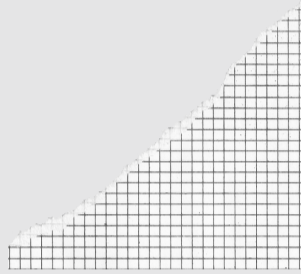
# CHOOSING A STUDIO MICROPHONE

### 2 KNOW MIC SPECS

- Dynamic (home studio / stage) OR Condenser (well treated rooms)
- Polar Patterns
- Frequency Response
- SPL handling capability
- Material used in construction



### 3 THE PURPOSE

Many microphones are made for specific applications / use!

For example: vocals only / wind instruments / drumkit set / podcasting / on-camera / multi-purpose



### 4 BUDGET

- It is a very **important** investment for your home studio. Don't compromise on it.
- Get high quality cables, which most ignore.
- Also buy a good quality mic stand.



### 5 BUILD YOUR LOCKER!

- A single mic can never help you record all kind of vocals or instruments.
- Keep adding mics as per your project requirements... and build yourself a mic locker!



### 6 MAINTENANCE

- Store mics in a dust-free environment
- Keep them in their own case or pouch
- Keep them away from sunlight
- And yes, keep using them often :-)
